

IMPORTANT:

Keep your COVID-19 vaccination record card safe!

This card shows key details about your COVID-19 vaccine: what type, when and where you received it, and how many doses.

**You may need this card to prove that you have been fully vaccinated against COVID-19 to:

- Attend school and/or work,
- Visit indoor spaces,
- Travel,
- Receive and record your COVID-19 vaccine booster.



Tip: Have a photo of your card stored on your phone so you can prove you're vaccinated while keeping your card safe at home.

Lost your card?

If you were vaccinated in the US and need a new card, try contacting:

- The place where you got the vaccine (such as a pharmacy or doctor's office)
- Your state health department's immunization registry
- Your case manager (if you have one) for help.

It's safe to be vaccinated again if you can't replace your card. Talk to your healthcare provider about your options.
