

# NRC-RIM Community Engagement Grant Application | Global Engagement Grants Program 2022-2023

Through the [Center for Global Health & Social Responsibility](#), the [National Resource Center for Refugees, Immigrants, and Migrants \(NRC-RIM\)](#) calls for proposals from community-based organizations serving Afghan immigrant communities in Minnesota to support innovative pilot projects that address the public health needs of newly-arrived Afghans. Up to two grants will be offered for up to \$40,000 each. Examples of public health needs include but are not limited to maternal and child health, immunizations, mental health, chronic disease, and navigating the U.S. healthcare system. Organizations are encouraged to propose pilot projects that have potential to be scaled and/or replicated in other locations.

Applications are due **Monday, October 31st, 2022 at 11:59pm CDT**. Funding will be made available January 1, 2023.
