Mothers x Mothers

Mothers for Mothers (MxM) is a peer health meetup hosted by mothers, for mothers to discuss the COVID-19 vaccine. The toolkits enable organizations to easily plan, budget, and host MxM meetups.

COMMUNITIES



Makespace

<u>Vaccination Is</u> consists of a series of templates that can be used to create hyperlocal messaging including posters, social media posts, fact sheets, and more that encourage refugee, immigrant, and migrant communities to consider the COVID-19 vaccine.

YOUTH



#NoJudgment

#NoJudgment was developed with a youth collective, and includes tools that help youth from refugee, immigrant, and migrant communities engage in judgment-free conversations around the COVID-19 vaccine. These tools help foster and navigate conversations.

The Immigrant Cooperative consists of multiple organizations that provide an array of services to the community.

Healthy Spaces can help you:



Build trust and comfort on arrival

Clients seeking healthcare are often dealing with complex issues. Welcoming them into the space will make them feel safe, which is important for someone navigating healthcare in the US for the first time.



Navigate the space Confidently

Clients seldom have the headspace and ability to take in a lot of information and long descriptive texts. Providing the right amount of direction at the right time helps people get where they need to be without feeling overwhelmed.



Keep the space versatile but functional

It's important to be able to adapt and change for evolving needs and different events, such as vaccination clinics and COVID-19 information sessions operating simultaneously.



Turn a space into a community hub.

The more staff and organizations are connected to a shared purpose and build trust with each other, the more they can work together to provide better services for RIM communities.
