

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT COVID-19 VACCINES AND GREEN CARDS

COVID-19 VACCINES ARE REQUIRED TO ADJUST YOUR IMMIGRATION STATUS

You will need to complete all required vaccines before applying for a green card. This includes the newly required COVID-19 vaccine.

EXCEPTIONS (WAIVERS) ARE BASED ON CERTAIN QUALIFICATIONS AND ARE RARE

If your doctor does not recommend the COVID-19 vaccine for you for medical reasons or if you meet other limited criteria, you can try applying for a waiver. Waivers can be complex and are rare. If you think you may qualify for a waiver, it's best to talk with an immigration attorney or legal representative.

VACCINES KEEP PEOPLE SAFE

Vaccines help keep people healthy and free from some diseases. COVID-19 has killed millions of people, including many in the U.S. The best and safest way to keep ourselves, our families, and our communities protected is with the vaccine.

CHOOSING TO WAIT TO ADJUST YOUR STATUS MAY NEGATIVELY IMPACT YOU

COVID-19 is here to stay and it is likely the vaccine requirement is too. It is best to talk with an immigration attorney or legal representative about possible consequences if you are considering waiting.

TALKING TO TRUSTED LEADERS MAY HELP IF YOU FEEL WORRIED

Healthcare professionals and many religious leaders support COVID-19 vaccination because it is a tested and safe way to prevent people from getting seriously ill or dying from COVID-19. A trusted medical professional can discuss any worries you may have.
